WATSAN Uganda supports a water and sanitation project amongst half a million people in a rural setting 4000 miles away in the North Kigezi and Kanungu areas of South West Uganda.

WATSAN is a partnership between supporters in the UK and our wonderful team in Uganda. We aim to offer as many opportunities as possible to bring the two together. The team love to have visitors and welcome the support and encouragement which they represent. 18 visitors from the UK in August this year will be a bonanza for them.....9 young people and 9 young at heart!

The visiting team, as well as bringing financial support, are keen to help with a particular project at a school called Rumbugu. Sanitation facilities are grossly overloaded and dilapidated, and there is only one water tap with an intermittent supply for the 400 children and staff.

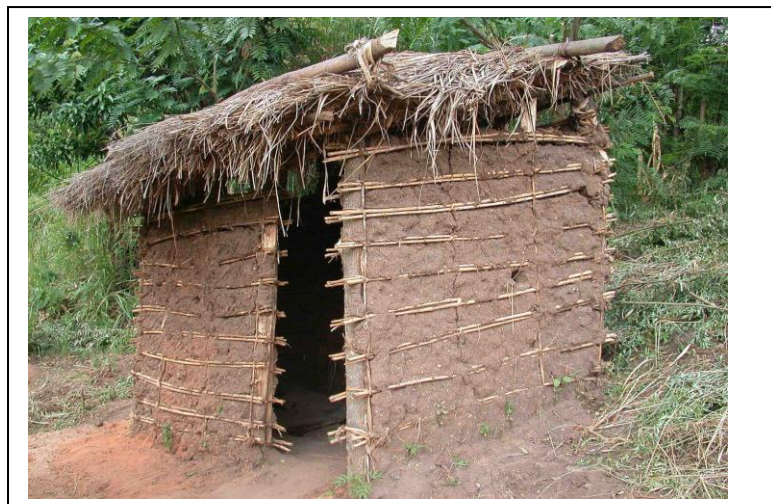

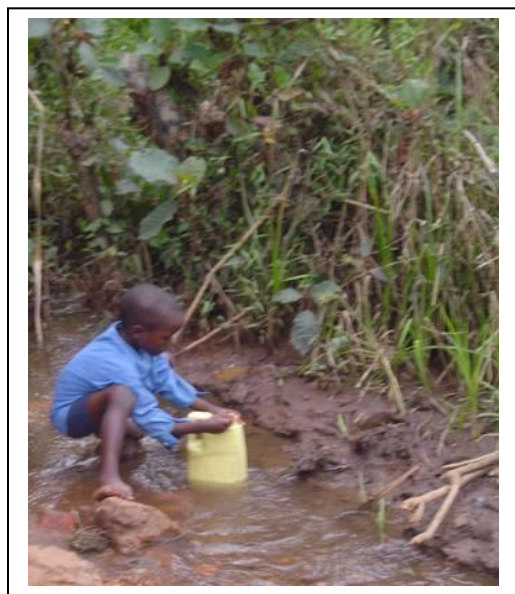


Before – traditional facility



After – clean, ventilated, fly and disease free (with hand washing)

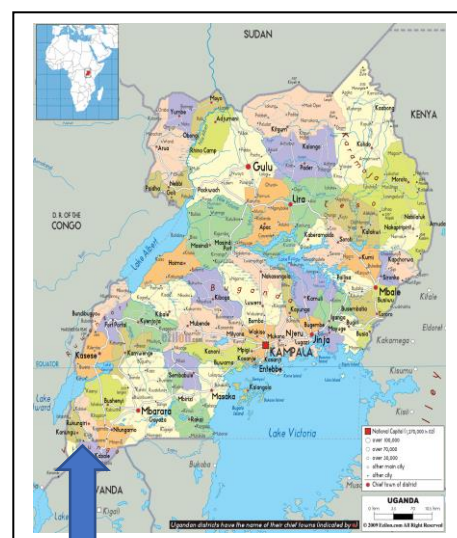
# Water Supply Improvements....
